




Resources for Teaching Idioms

Ed is one of the TEACH volunteers who tutors at St. Joseph Curch in Addison IL. Now retired, he used to teach music at a school in Villa Park. Ed played the French horn, taught wind instruments to young people and conducted brass ensembles from 1958-1980. He also worked for a company that made outdoor signs, managing accounts and projects.

Ed and his wife raised seven children. He became interested in tutoring after seeing an article in a parish newsletter in Wood Dale asking for volunteer tutors. Ed decided he would give it a try. Five years later at 90 years young, he continues enjoying tutoring his students Gabi and Jorge.

Ed explains, "To learn English is to extend your attention to detail when you realize you have to memorize a great amount of information. I am always proud of my students with the slight improvements they make. I enjoy talking with my students about our families, and how to raise children to be respectful and successful in this world."
