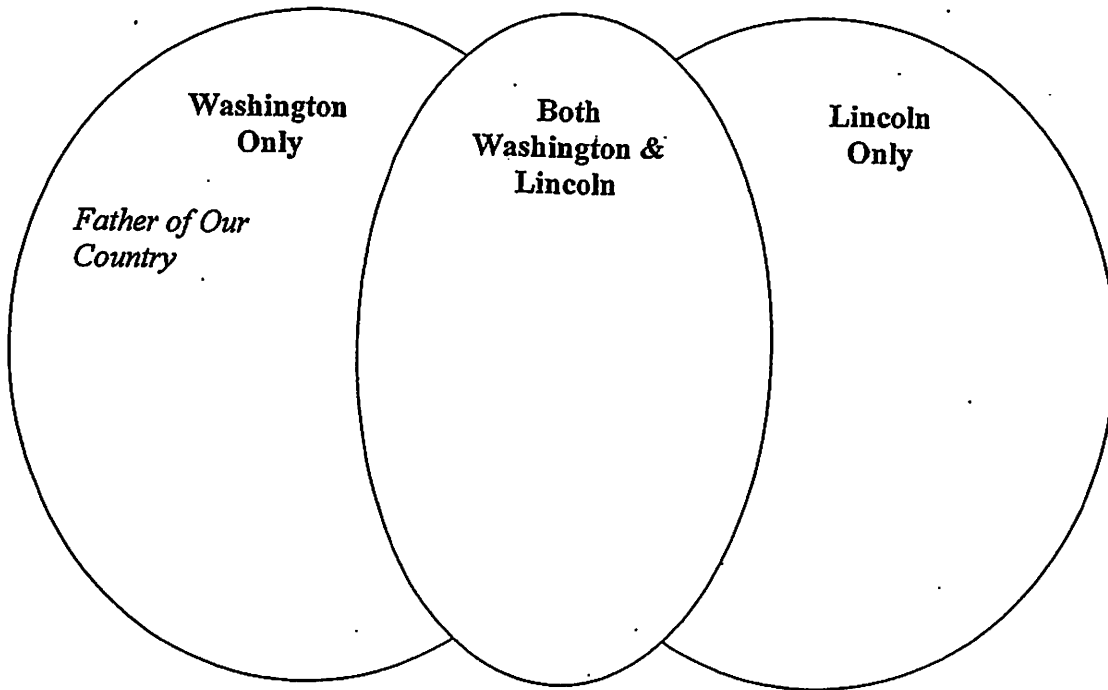
1. George Washington was the first President of the United States. He is called the "Father of Our Country".

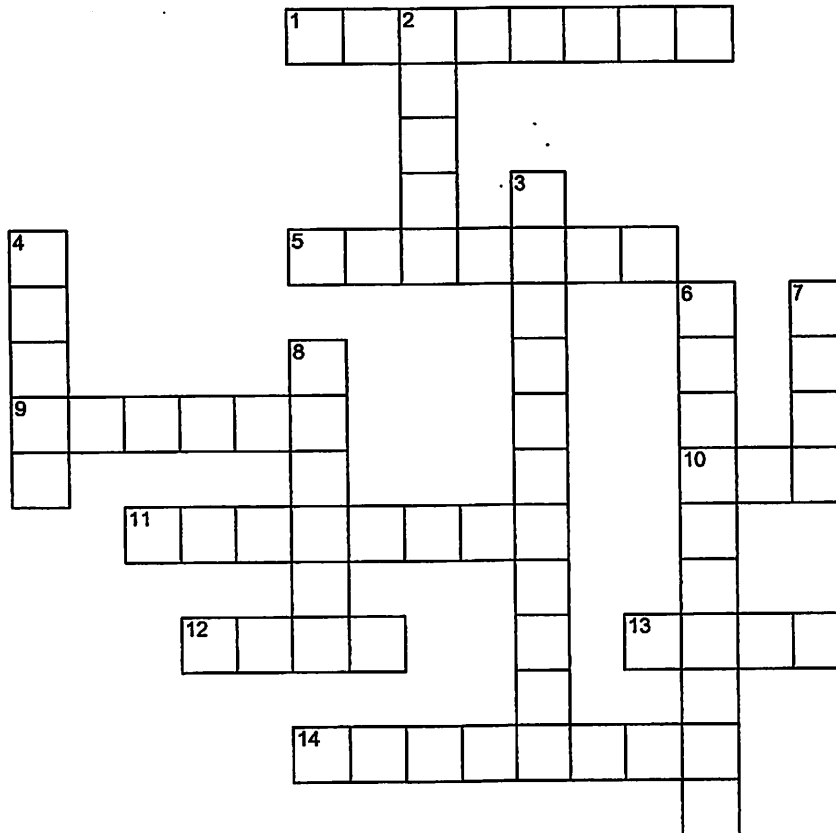
