- **Tutoring**
  - Tutor a student remotely
  - Work with a student that does not have technology available by making telephone calls for short conversations and mailing packets (packets provided/postage at tutor expense)
  - Work with the Conversation Group to tutor students
  - Write and mail notes to students
- **Developing Tutoring and Study Materials**
  - Develop lesson plans for individual tutoring sessions and Conversation Group
  - Help to create teaching ideas for our resources
  - Help to create packets to mail to students
  - Help to create Quizlets for our textbooks and other resources
- **Technology Mentor**
  - Help tutors and students learn to access and use new technologies
- **Tutor Training and Support**
  - Help set-up and lead tutor email groups
  - Attend professional development meetings, read articles, attend webinars, participate in email conversation groups with other tutors
- **Communications**
  - Help create and distribute a student newsletter
  - Tell others about TEACH and how they can support us
  - Recruit new students and tutors
  - Read our newsletters
  - Like us on Facebook
- **Socialize**
  - Come to Zoom social events to build community and support
- **Community Resources**
  - Share information about local resources that could support students
- **Donations**
  - Donate to help offset extra expenses (buy a book for a student or a tutor/help pay for extra envelopes and postage)
